The wedding feast of Cana is not primarily a parable about a wedding. In the three Synoptic Gospels, Matthew, Mark and Luke, the public life of Jesus began with his baptism by John in the Jordan River. John has no public baptism. For John, the public introduction of Jesus to the people is at the wedding at Cana. The emphasis is not on marriage but on the introduction of Jesus to the people. The situation as described by John is a baptismal event because of his description of the number of jars of water accumulated for the ceremony. The translation of the jars of water into wine is a symbol of the new order of life that Jesus has introduced. It is a reminder of the miracle that baptism introduces into the life of a new Christian.

In John's Gospel, Jesus began his public life with a miracle defining his essence. The hour of Jesus is his passage from death to life. His own disciples reduced him to a miracle worker. They could not comprehend that he was the one who would rise from the dead. The mother of Jesus asked him to provide wine for the wedding and so Jesus did. Yet his contribution to the occasion was not his provision of wine but of the fact that he was the Messiah, the promised one. But this was not his HOUR; his HOUR would only come with the moment of his death and resurrection.

Everything Jesus did expressed his HOUR, his defining moment. But this was understood only after his death and resurrection. Jesus came as one who serves. He gave away his life for the sake of those he served. His glorious death on the Cross symbolised and expressed the meaning of his entire life.
