The Passion of Jesus, his suffering, is an integral part of our life. In the Liturgy, we partake in the events of which led to the death of Jesus. We can only achieve this empathy with Jesus if we have regularly prayed and meditated on the meaning of Jesus' life for us.

There was nothing 'nice' about the events of the last weeks of Jesus' life. Here was the man from Nazareth who had been rejected by most of his townspeople; he had been rejected by the Jewish officials of Nazareth as a 'false messiah'. He was even rejected by his close disciples. When Peter was asked: 'Are you one of his disciples?' he answered: 'No, I am not!' What is the meaning of suffering and what is the place of suffering in our lives?

None of us can explain suffering but each one of us is capable of providing ways to cope with suffering. We often use our faith in God as a means to escape from the everyday sufferings of life. God is our refuge and protection from suffering. Yet when we cling to God and still suffer, we usually blame God for not protecting us.

Jesus was fully human, yet he was also the Son of God. Being fully human as well as being fully divine meant that he was not able to use God as an escape from his human problems. When we endure suffering, let us emulate the manner of Jesus who did not run away from the sufferings of life but faced these trials gladly as the necessary obstacles to be faced in the journey of life to God, who is our Father and Protector.
