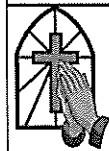

Guilt paralyses and destroys confidence. To feel that what I am or what I have done is so bad that no one else could understand me or forgive me leads to despair. This is not God's will for us. Hebrews assures us: *'Let us be confident, then, in approaching the throne of grace that we shall have mercy from him and find grace when we are in need of help. For it is not as if we had a high priest who was incapable of feeling our weaknesses with us; but we have one who has been tempted in every way that we are, though he is without sin.'*

Everyone's life has its share of suffering, but suffering from guilt is not what God intends for us. Because guilt is a destructive emotion, it cannot lead to growth. Of itself guilt is not life giving. It is linked to shame. In the Adam and Eve story, they hid from God because they were ashamed after their sin. Guilt is based on fear of failure. It is based on a feeling of being inadequate in the eyes of those who are important to us - parents, brothers or sisters, friends, employers, and whose approval is important to us.

God is a very wise parent. Jesus is a very wise elder brother. They have never set out to make us feel failures. Yes God has continually called us to repent of our sins. Jesus points out the error of our ways. Yet this is so we will experience mercy, not guilt. God wants us to perform and we will perform only when we have confidence in our abilities and our potential.
